The White Horse on the Hambleton Hills can be seen from the brewery. In 1997 Hambleton Ales gained the coveted award of CAMRA Champion Winter Beer of Britain for its Nightmare brand.

Wold Top Brewery was founded in 2003 by arable farmers Tom and Gill Mellor. Based high on the Yorkshire Wolds where the hills roll down to the North Sea. Their debut ale, Peg Fyfe is a dark mild (3.6%) named after the local Goodmanham witch who was hanged in the early 1700's.
